Dan Goeller is a composer whose colorful orchestrations and accessible compositional style have delighted audiences and performers around the world and have been widely published. Dan has also worked on numerous recordings and several tours with artists including Amy Grant, Vince Gill, Michael W. Smith, CeCe Winans, Nickel Creek, Larnelle Harris and others. Dan's music, often under his own direction as a conductor, has been performed by numerous orchestras and choruses including the National Symphony, Atlanta Symphony, St. Louis Symphony, Nashville Symphony and many others. Dan's compositions have been programmed on numerous nationally televised concerts and have also been featured in both regional and national radio and television broadcasts.

Dan and his wife, Heidi, founded Harmony South Dakota in January 2014. Harmony SD is an El Sistema-inspired after-school program providing children ages six and older with the opportunity to cultivate the life skills necessary to become healthy and compassionate citizens while fostering a harmonious community where everyone is known, loved, and valued.
