Festival Extension (4 nights/5 days)

Day 1 Sunday, June 1, 2025 Lucerne (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel, followed by check-out

Morning transfer to Lucerne

Lunch, on own

Enjoy an orientation tour of Lucerne. This picture book-like town includes the Covered Wooden Bridge, Mussegge Towers, the Lion Monument and the old town. Also enjoy some shopping time including items such as Swiss watches, lace, wood carvings and chocolate

Dinner included, and overnight

Lucerne is the capital of its canton and considered one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland. The lake resort city sprawls at the foot of Lake Lucerne in the cradle of historic Switzerland. The city's medieval heritage is evident in the fortifying walls and towers, the old churches and houses and the unusual covered bridges that span the Reuss

Day 2 Monday, June 2 Lucerne (B)

Breakfast at the hotel

Half-day guided sightseeing tour of Lucerne. Visit old town and encounter the iconic Chapel Bridge, the oldest wooden covered bridge in Europe, adorned with colorful murals. This historic landmark, dating back to the 14th century, offers a picturesque view of the Reuss River and the Water Tower, a symbol of Lucerne. Also see the poignant Lion Monument, a powerful sculpture commemorating the Swiss Guards who died during the French Revolution. Finally, get a glimpse into Lucerne's medieval past with a visit to the Musegg Wall, a well-preserved city wall with nine towers

Lunch, on own

Afternoon cruise across the tranquil waters of Lake Lucerne. Glide across the crystal-clear waters, and be surrounded by the stunning backdrop of the Swiss Alps, with their snow-capped peaks soaring into the sky. The cruise goes past picturesque lakeside villages like Weggis and Vitznau, each exuding a unique charm with their traditional Swiss architecture and vibrant floral displays. Also see historic landmarks such as the towering Bürgenstock Resort and the iconic Mount Pilatus

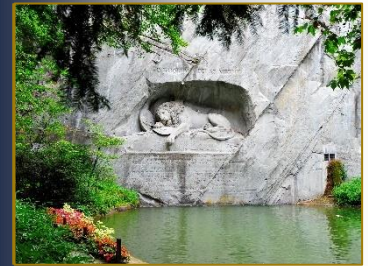
Dinner on own, and overnight

Day 3 Tuesday, June 3 Mt. Pilatus / Lucerne (B,D)

Breakfast at the hotel

Sightseeing includes travel on the cog-railroad, which runs up through Alpine meadows (orchards) and forests to the passing station at Ämsigen and then continues over the rock-strewn Mattalp and up the steep rock face, through four tunnels, to the upper station on Pilatus-Kulm. From here it is a 6-10 minute climb to the summit (surrounded by a wall) of the Esel, the central but not the highest peak of Pilatus, from which there are magnificent views of the Alps, from Säntis to the Blümlisalp, Lakes Lucerne and Zug, and the Swiss uplands

Transfer to the Zurich Airport for return flight home
